

GUIDE TO THE HANDBOOK OF POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

The *Macquarie University Handbook of Postgraduate Studies* is one of three volumes that together represent the official reference to Macquarie University. It includes an overview of the University, details of University legislation, rules and regulations, principal dates in the University year and names of staff members at the time of publication.

PART ONE UNIVERSITY OVERVIEW

The first Part of the Handbook begins with an introduction to Macquarie University and gives some general information about the campus. It includes the principal dates for 2008 and details the various services, facilities and resources available to students and staff. Information on the various University museums, teaching collections, research resources and Centres is also included.

PART TWO POSTGRADUATE STUDY

The second Part of the Handbook contains all formal information relating to postgraduate study; the rules governing study, general postgraduate student information and details relating to admission, enrolment, records, examinations, scholarships and prizes. This Part also includes degrees and diplomas offered followed by some more detailed information on programs of postgraduate study and research in the various Divisions and Departments of the University.

PART THREE PROGRAMS AND UNITS

This Part of the Handbook contains the schedule of postgraduate coursework programs of study and every unit of postgraduate study offered, with a brief description of each unit. A schedule of coursework units is also provided.
